From The Farm’s Kitchen...

Take the chill out of the air and warm up with a bowl of our *very favorite, best of the best...*

Corn Chowder

1/2 pound bacon, diced	1 medium onion, chopped (about ½ cup)
1/2 cup chopped celery (with tops)	2 Tablespoons. flour
4 cups milk	1 can cream style corn
1 can tiny whole potatoes, diced	1/2 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon pepper	Snipped parsley

In large saucepan, fry bacon until crisp; remove and drain. Pour all but 3 tablespoons drippings from saucepan. Add onion and celery to drippings in pan; cook and stir until onion is tender. Remove from heat; blend in flour. Cook over low heat, stirring until mixture is bubbly. Remove from heat. Stir in milk. Heat to boiling, stirring constantly. Boil and stir 1 minute. Stir in corn, potatoes, salt and pepper; heat through. Stir in bacon. Sprinkle each serving with parsley and paprika. 6 Servings (1 cup each).
